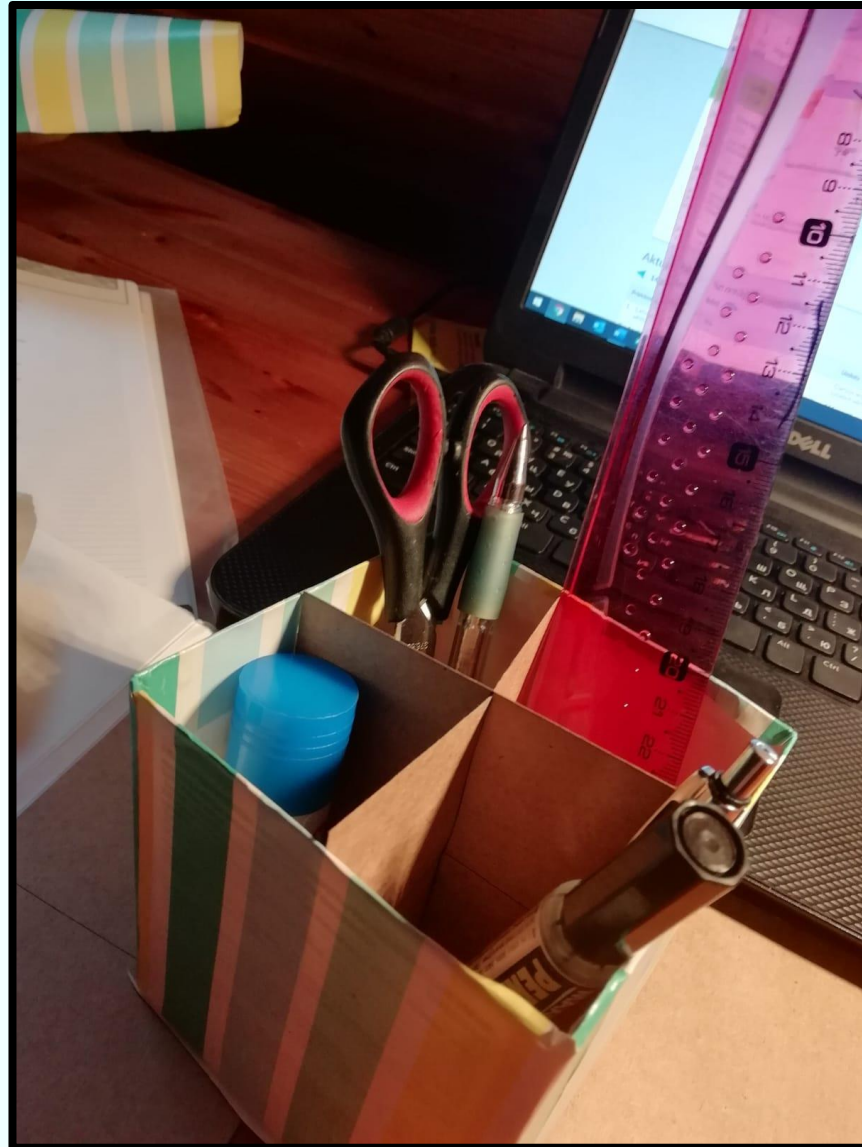


Practical experiment: accessory dish

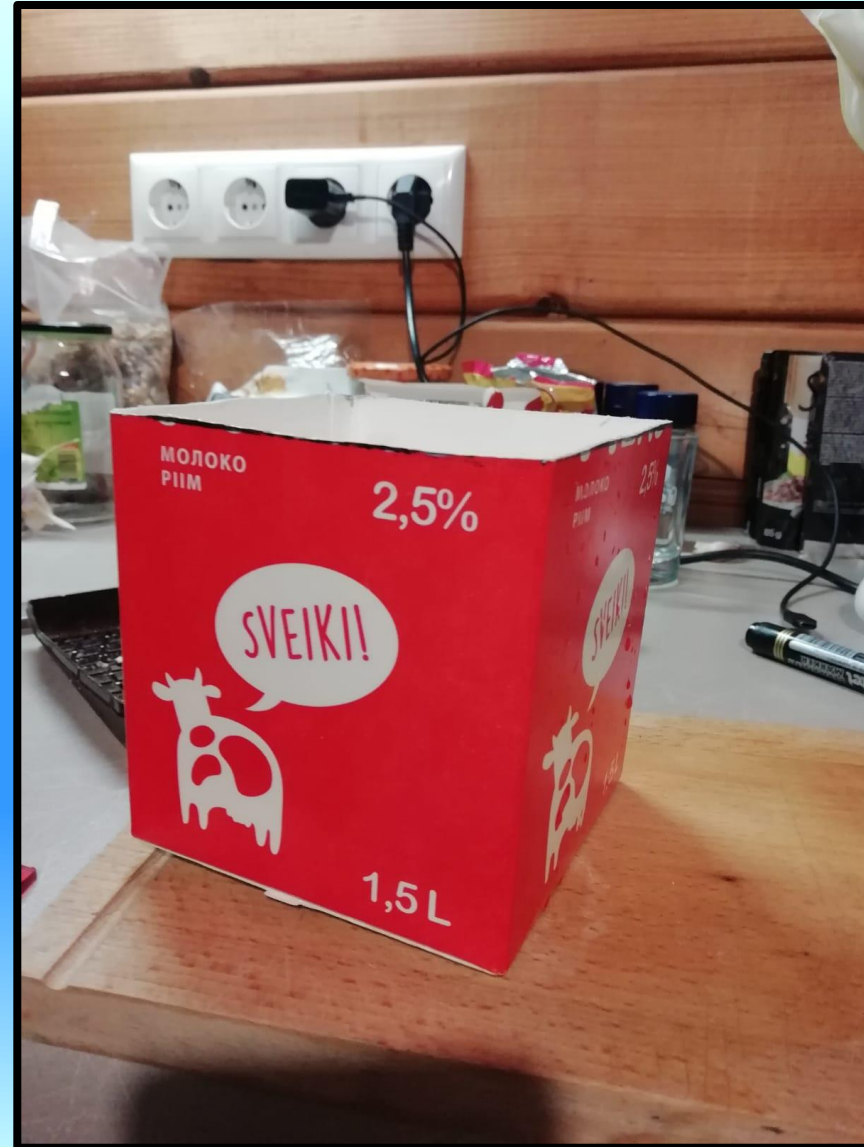
You will need:

- Empty milk pack;
- Scissors;
- Pen ;
- Cardboard ;
- Glue ;
- Gift paper.



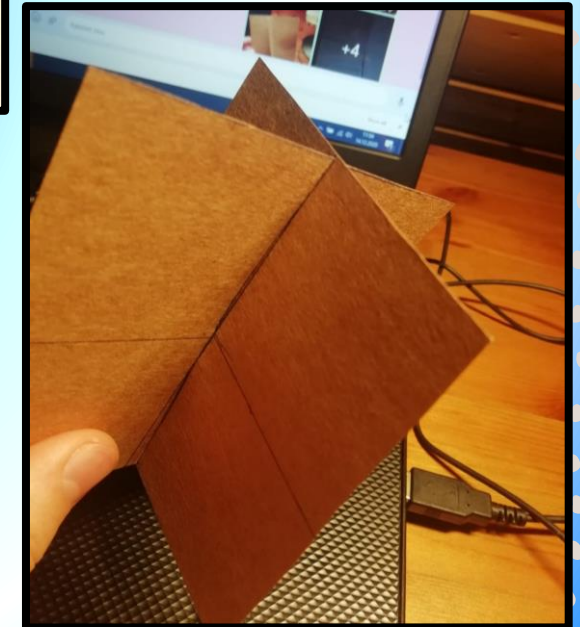
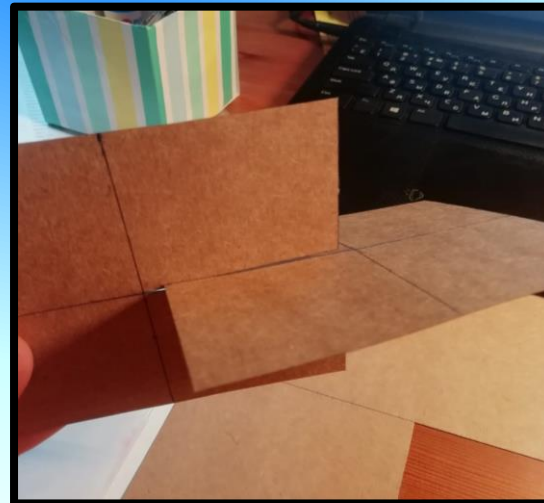
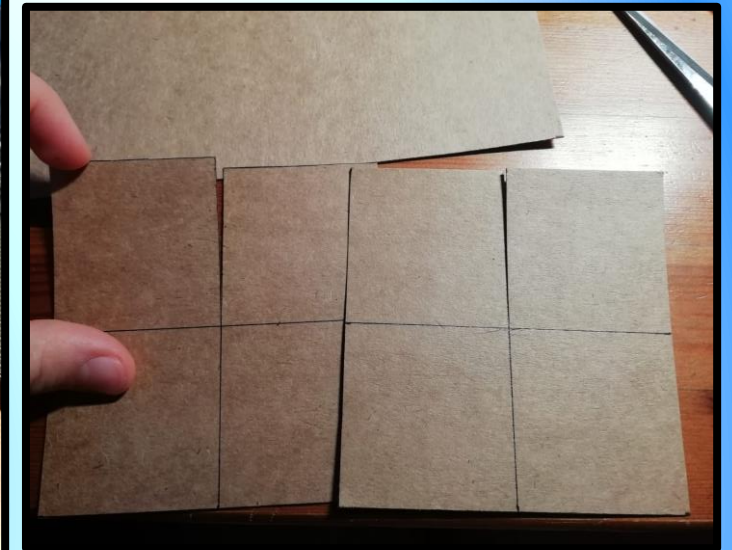
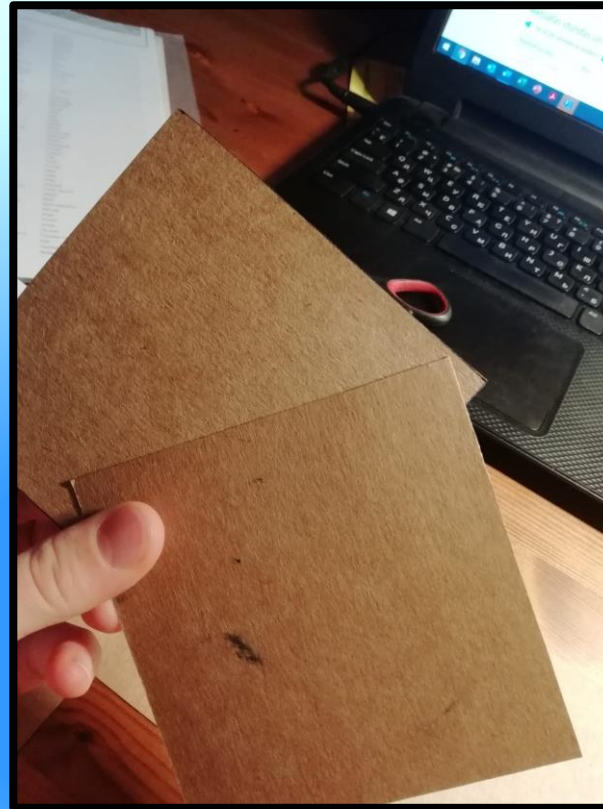
1. Cut the milk pack up.

Cut from the milk pack as much, as you want your accessory dish.



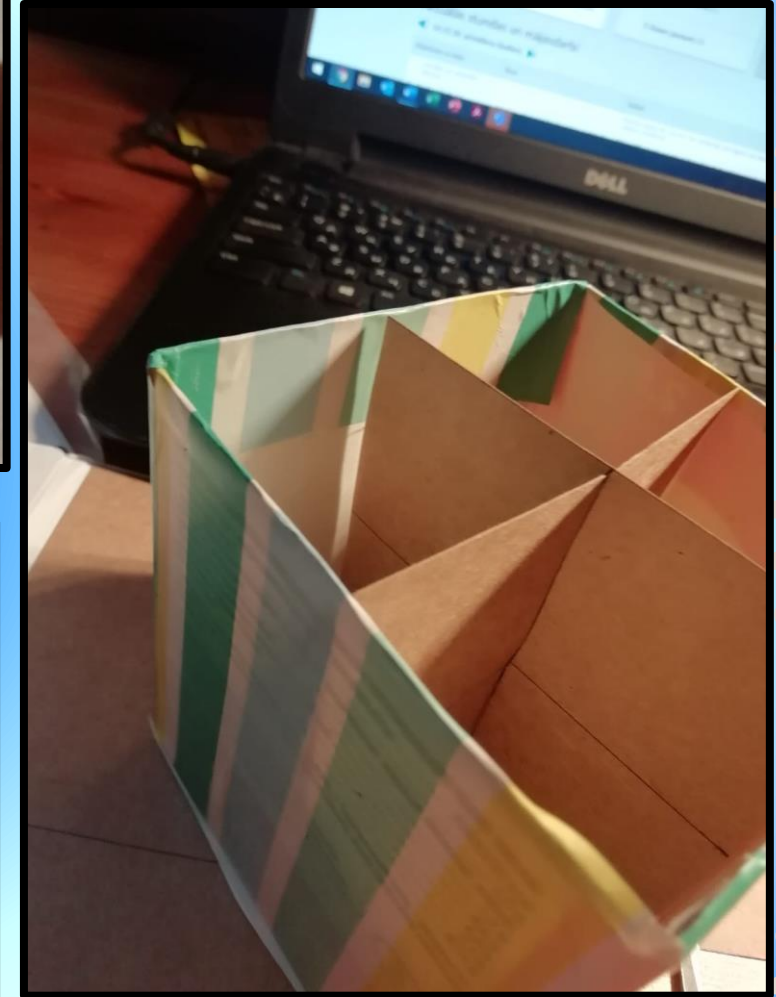
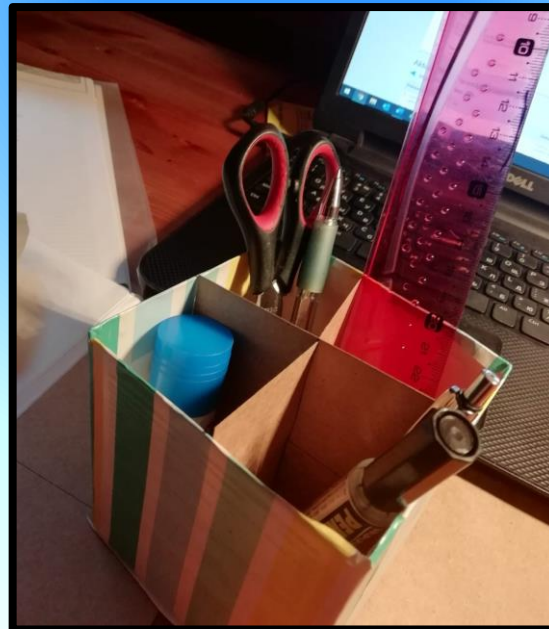
2. Division of the vessel into four parts.

You have to cut from the cardboard as big, two squares as the wall of the milk pack. Once you've done that, accurately divide the two squares into four equal parts with a pen. In order to create walls from squares, you have to cut one line in each square, exactly to the middle of the square. Then put those two squares together by incisions, from it to make four parts.



3. Make it look like accessory dish.

First you have to take your milk pack, who looks like box , and to make it look beautifuler you can wrap it in gift paper, and when you have done that you can put in your four parts of cardboard, and now it looks like real accessory dish!
