

How to make denim feathers

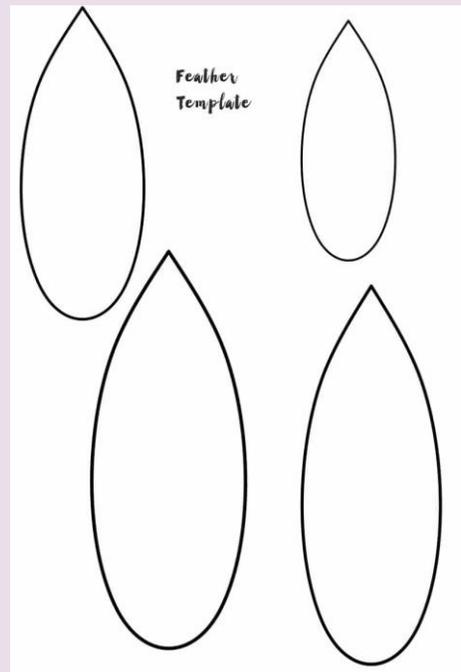
- *What you will need to make denim feathers*
 - *A piece of denim*
 - *Paper*
 - *Scissors*
 - *String of yarn*
 - *Fabric glue (but I used PVA glue)*
- *Steps to make denim feathers*

1. Find a piece of denim

(here I'm using my ripped pants as the material)



2. Cut out a feather template



3. Then put the template on the material to know how much to cut off



(here I decided that I can fit two feathers on one piece)

4. Now cut the pants leg in half, like so:



5. Outline the template on the fabric



6. *Cut a string of yarn, how long you want it to be*
7. *Glue on the string so it goes vertically down the middle*



8. *And now comes the difficult part – you have to fray the denim by pulling out the threads*

I liked the process, but it does get a little messy by all the glue and pulled out thread. I think I did well in the sense of second use material and upcycling, because everything I used was bought some time ago and didn't have to buy anything for this project. I'm not sure, but I expect the fabric glue to be better than PVA glue. One thing I didn't like in the making of the feather is that it is very time-consuming, one feather took me about an hour. You might need to do it a few times to get a nice-looking feather. This was my first try so I'm not surprised it didn't come out as good. I recommend when you're gluing the string on, don't let the glue spread out, but have it as close to the middle as possible due-to the will harden and will be hard to fray it.
